

# FFY 2022 CLG GRANT AWARDS

## \$120,500 to Local Governments from Wisconsin SHPO

Each year, the Wisconsin State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) gives 10% of its allocation from the federal *Historic Preservation Fund* to Certified Local Governments (CLGs) around the state. All of our 74 CLGs are eligible for grant funding for historic preservation planning projects.

#### CITY OF ALLOUEZ - BROWN CO.

**\$12,500** to prepare a National Register nomination for the Sunset Circle Historic District, a district of (How many) mid-20th-century homes.

#### CITY OF GREEN BAY - BROWN CO.

**\$36,500** to complete the third phase of a survey of the city to identify historically significant properties.

### CITY OF MADISON - DANE CO.

**\$26,500** to conduct a survey of archaeological sites in the city to inform development decisions, and to formalize consultation with Native tribes.

#### CITY OF MILWAUKEE - MILWAUKEE CO.

**\$45,000** to survey all purpose-built religious buildings in the city built between 1920 and 1985.
