- New grant dates are April 2022-April 2024, grant start delayed at the request of Angela Fritz, the former State Archivist and Division Administrator of the Wisconsin Historical Society.

- Generally, slightly behind on grant objectives due to the four month delay in grant start and difficulty hiring for the WHRAB Assistant
- Archives Month
 - Anita would like the WHRAB to resume Archives Month programming. Discussed past use as fundraising tool, consider using an author who could discuss/sign book at program.
 - Clayborn- Archives Month is an important tool. Encourage people to continue to collect and highlight historical people and objects. Similar activities to the Milwaukee Open House

 - o Ask for events that others are putting on
 - o Could we ask in a local history email (question for WHS office of local history)
 - O Discuss in Feb. 2023 about the identification of a theme
