

Wisconsin Historical Records Advisory Board Scholarship Application



The Wisconsin Historical Records Advisory Board (WHRAB), in conjunction with the National Historical Publications and Records Commission (NHPRC) encourages graduate students currently enrolled in a Wisconsin institution of higher education and individuals currently working (or volunteering) in a Wisconsin repository, library, and/or local historical society to apply for an award to seek professional development opportunities.

Eligibility: Applicants must be graduate students currently enrolled in a Wisconsin institution or archivists currently working (or volunteering) in a Wisconsin repository, library, and/or local historical society. Recipients are eligible for a WHRAB scholarship no more than once each calendar year. No advance payments will be made; recipients will be reimbursed for conference-related expenses supported by documentation. Recipients are solely responsible for any tax obligations. 
