

2017 School Tour Subsidy Information for Old World Wisconsin

Purpose:

In keeping with the educational mission of the museum, it is our goal to make Old World Wisconsin available to as many school children as possible by offering financial subsidies to qualifying schools. These subsidies are funded through the generosity of the Old World Wisconsin Foundation.

Eligibility:

Any non-profit educational institution that instructs children from kindergarten through grade 12 may apply for the subsidy. The application must be submitted at least three weeks prior to the field trip date. Funds may <u>not</u> be used to reimburse schools for field trips that have already been taken; however, you may make your field trip reservation before applying for the subsidy.

Award:

Qualifying schools will receive an award letter redeemable for a reduced or free admission for each student, to be credited to your account upon arrival at Old World Wisconsin. **Subsidy approval amounts are for student admission fees only. The subsidy cannot be used for bussing or transportation costs.** Chaperone fees will be due two weeks before the trip to Old World Wisconsin. The amount of award will vary, based on subsidy monies available and the financial need of the applicant school.

Application Procedure:

Educators interested in applying for the subsidy should complete the School Tour Subsidy Application form. Forms may be mailed, faxed, or hand-delivered to the Tour Coordinator at the address listed below. Applications must be submitted at least three weeks prior to your preferred field trip date. If you do not already have a confirmed tour date, please complete the School Tour Request Form located on our website. The tour request can be submitted along with your subsidy application and will be processed simultaneously.

Notification will be mailed within two weeks after receipt of the application by Old World Wisconsin. **Schools must furnish proof of acceptance on the day of the field trip** in order to receive the subsidy (proof is the award letter you will receive if accepted). Awardwinners will also be expected to complete a brief evaluation of their field trip experience.

Award Criteria:

Applicants will be ranked according to the following criteria:

- Integration of the field trip experience into classroom curriculum.
- Financial need of the school and/or percentage of its students.
- Awards are provided every two years. Please do not apply if you received a subsidy within the last field trip season.
