This form must be complete, signed and received in our office for your child to have a confirmed registration.

Parental Consent

1. I give my consent for Old World Wisconsin Camp Staff to act on my behalf to obtain emergency care and treatment if deemed necessary for my child. I hereby give my consent for emergency medical care or treatment of my child in the event that I cannot be reached immediately. The Old World Wisconsin *Camp Agreement, Health Information and Emergency Consent* must be complete, signed and in our office before your child is considered registered in Day Camp. You will receive a confirmation of completed registration.
2. I give my consent for my child to be transported on site to and from any scheduled program activity for which transportation is provided.
3. I give my consent for Old World Wisconsin Camp Staff to apply sunscreen and insect repellent to my child as conditions warrant.
4. I give permission to have my child appear in any media coverage approved by Old World Wisconsin.
5. I understand that my child will be in a rural farm and outdoor setting and may be exposed to domestic and wild animals and insects. To ensure the safety of all campers, my child is expected to follow the rules and expectations set out by Old World Wisconsin Camp Staff.
6. I understand that Old World Wisconsin reserves the right to remove a camper if it is found that he/she requires an unusual amount of individual attention, whether due to special needs or behavior problems, or if the Camp Staff feels it is unable to meet the needs of the camper effectively in the Day Camp setting.
7. I understand that Old World Wisconsin Day Camps have limited accommodations for children with special needs.

Payment of Fees

1. I understand the fee for each camp is due at the time of registration. Space cannot be guaranteed without receipt of payment. No fee credit will be given for days missed during a multiple day camp.
2. I understand that a \$25.00 charge is assessed for each Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF) check.
3. I understand that a fee of \$5.00 per 15 minutes or any portion thereof is charged if my child is dropped off early or remains after any program for which he/she is registered.
4. I understand that I must cancel by May 31, 2017 in order to receive a refund of 50% of my camp fees. After May 31st, I understand that my camp fee is **non-refundable**. You may, instead, transfer your registration to a different camp or offer your child's camp to a sibling or friend of the same grade range (subject to availability). In order for correct paperwork to be completed, we must be notified at least 48 hours in advance if your child's registration is transferred to another participant.
5. I understand that Old World Wisconsin reserves the right to cancel any camp and that I will receive a full refund in such an event.

Medication: If your child requires any medications (prescription or non-prescription) while they are attending our day camp, medications must be in the original container. Prescription medication container must identify the child, the medication, the dosage, prescribing physician, and written instructions for administering the medication. Medications received in any container other than the original will not be accepted. We will store the medication for your child to self-administer.

- I give permission for my child to receive the following medication during camp hours. I have prepared my child to self-medicate. I understand that if my child refuses to self-medicate, force will not be used to make him/her comply. I will then be notified and may be required to pick up my child. I understand that if my child is not capable of administering any medication as needed, a parent or guardian must remain with the Day Camp for the duration of the program.
- If medication is an inhaler or Epi-pen, I request that my child be permitted to carry it with him/her and agree that my child is capable of administering the medication as needed.
- I release Old World Wisconsin and its staff and volunteers from any and all liability that may result from following or failure to follow the instructions above.

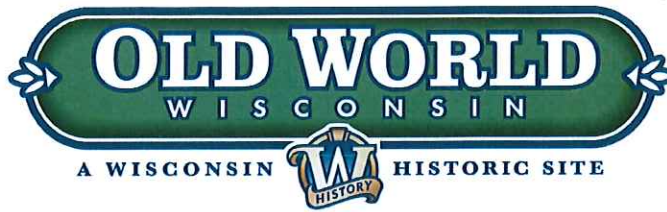

Thank you for requesting registration forms for Day Camp at Old World Wisconsin! We have plenty of exciting activities in store this year, and we can't wait to get started. We want you to have a fun and safe experience, so please carefully review the following guidelines as a family. REGISTRATION PAPERWORK

There are two ways to register for Day Camp at Old World Wisconsin:

- 1. You can fill out this packet** of all of the required forms (available as a download on our website). Completed forms can be mailed or faxed to Old World Wisconsin.
- 2. You can register online.** If you register online, you will receive the Camp Agreement, Health Information Form and Emergency Consent Form as an attachment in your registration confirmation email. You will need to complete and sign all forms and mail or fax them back to us. Your registration is NOT FINAL until we have received all completed forms.

We must have **all** completed forms on file before we can allow your child to participate in Day Camp. Bringing any on the day of your child's camp will delay your sign-in process, so please try to mail or fax all of them in at least one week before your camp. If you have any questions or need additional copies of any form, please email us at owweducation@wisconsinhistory.org or call us at 262-594-6312 and we will be happy to help.

CANCELLATIONS

If you're unable to attend camp and must cancel, 50% of your fee will be refunded if cancelled by May 31, 2017. After May 31, 2017, your fee is non-refundable, but you may transfer your payment to a different 2017 camp session or transfer your reservation to a friend or relative of the same grade range (subject to availability). We must be informed at least 48 hours in advance if your child's registration is transferred to another participant.

MUSEUM STORE

If your child wants to visit our Museum Store, we ask that you not send money along, but accompany them after camp ends at 3 pm. Camp Staff will be happy to direct you to the Museum Store at that time.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP

If your daytime phone number will be different than what you provided on the registration form, please provide our staff with a number where you can be reached during the camp session.

One-Room Schoolhouse Rocks, Little House Adventures, Civil War Camp, Farm-To-Table, Amazing Race, Animals Up Close, Baking Back in Time; and Pioneer Power camps begin at 8:30 am and end at 3 pm. Meet at the Heritage Picnic Pavilion, located at the Norwegian Area/Ward School entrance (about .6 mile south of the main entrance on Hwy 67.) At 9 am the Norwegian Area gate will be closed and campers will move to other parts of the museum. Please return to the Norwegian Picnic Pavilion and sign out with Day Camp staff at 3 pm.

Old World Apprentice Camp begins at 9:15 am and ends at 3 pm, with both drop off and pick up in the parking lot, near the Visitor Center which can be reached via our Main Entrance on Hwy 67.

We appreciate the chance to speak with you about any successes or challenges we've had during the day and to distribute any notes or handouts. Old World Wisconsin is open to other visitors at this time, so it is very important that you park in the designated parking areas. If you decide to stay and visit the Museum while your child is in camp, please do not follow your child's group throughout the day. This can be very disruptive to the campers' on-site experience. Your cooperation is appreciated. **Late fee policy:** there is a \$5 charge for every 15 minutes a child stays past pick up time.

FOOD AND BEVERAGES

We serve a healthy mid-morning snack to all Day Camps. Please inform us of any food-related allergies on your registration form. Parents/Guardians are responsible for providing a water bottle and lunch (food and beverage) for children attending Day Camp. Refrigeration is not available to store your lunches. Please do not send soda to camp with your child (it attracts both wasps and cavities). Campers may drink water, juice, sports drinks, or any other beverage of your choice.

One Room Schoolhouse Rocks! campers are encouraged to bring lunches appropriate to the early 1900s, wrapped in waxed or brown paper, to get a more authentic feel for having lunch in a one-room schoolhouse.

Farm-To-Table campers: lunch is provided (you will be cooking a meal over a wood-burning stove as part of the camp experience.) Please be sure to inform us of any food-related allergies during registration so that we may plan accordingly.

Baking Back in Time campers: Please be sure to inform us of any food-related allergies during registration so that we may plan accordingly.

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

Day Camps at Old World Wisconsin are an indoor/outdoor adventure! We want you to be fully prepared so please bring the following:

- Backpack (no sharing – everyone needs their own)
- Water Bottle
- Comfortable shoes for hiking on gravel roads and forest trails
- Clothes appropriate for the weather (see below for camp-specific clothing)
- Light Jacket – just in case
- Sunscreen & insect repellent (all-in-one lotion recommended – we'll help re-apply as necessary)
- Hat and sunglasses (optional)

Do NOT bring cell phones or other electronic devices.

CLOTHING & OPTIONAL COSTUMING

Campers should wear comfortable shoes for hiking on gravel roads and clothes appropriate for the weather. This includes a light jacket, sunscreen and insect repellent. Campers have the option to bring a hat and sunglasses.

It is common for camp attendees to dress in the manner of children of the 1800s. While not required, we certainly encourage costuming as a way to increase a child's understanding of the period. If the spirit moves you, historic clothing patterns for children's clothing can be found online and at most fabric stores.

For Boys: Blue jeans, a loose fitting cotton, long-sleeved shirt and suspenders work well. Black shoes and socks can complete the look.

For Girls: A prairie dress and bonnet, with black shoes, are good choices. A simple dress and apron also work well. We have a selection of bonnets for sale at our museum store.

Old World Apprentice Campers will be contacted for size information. Our Period Clothing Coordinator will then fit each camper with their costume from our collection of historically accurate clothing.

Civil War Campers will be issued a uniform jacket, small satchel and wooden musket for the day. Bring long pants for walking in the woods.

From Milwaukee

Downtown and Northern Suburbs: Take I-94 west to WI-67 (Oconomowoc exit). Head south on WI-67 approximately 15 miles to Old World Wisconsin, following signs to the site. Drive past the main entrance on WI- 67, continuing south on WI-67. After intersection with Cty-LO, turn Right into Norwegian/Ward School Area.

South Milwaukee and Southern Suburbs: Take I-894 to US-43 to WI-83 in Mukwonago. Head north on WI-83 to CR-NN, then west on CR-NN to WI-67 in Eagle. Head south on WI-67 to Old World Wisconsin, following signs to the site. Drive past the main entrance on WI- 67, continuing south on WI-67. After intersection with Cty-LO, turn Right into Norwegian/Ward School Area.

From Madison

Take I-94 east to WI-67 (Oconomowoc exit). Head south on WI-67 approximately 15 miles to Old World Wisconsin, following signs to the site. Drive past the main entrance on WI- 67, continuing south on WI-67. After intersection with Cty-LO, turn Right into Norwegian/Ward School Area.

From Chicago

Lake Shore and Southern Suburbs: Take I-94 north toward Wisconsin. Exit WI-20 at Racine. Continue west on WI-20 to WI-67. Go north on WI-67 an additional seven miles to Old World Wisconsin. After intersection with Cty-S, watch for and turn left into Norwegian/Ward School Area.

West and Northwest Suburbs: Take US-12 to WI-67 in Elkhorn. Go north on WI-67 an additional 13 miles to Old World Wisconsin. After intersection with Cty-S, watch for and turn left into Norwegian/Ward School Area.
