Purpose

WHS has a **three-year NHPRC grant** focused on providing access to state government electronic records.

WHS is often approached with questions about large-scale records digitization projects.

These projects often include active records and records of long-term value.

Development

Project staff drew on institutional knowledge and research to put together a set of **ten guidance documents**.

There are two versions: one for state agencies and one for local units of government.

Both received approval from the Public Records Board in November 2017.

Specific **resolution and file format guidelines** based on length of retention and purpose






