



## JUDGING CRITERIA

(Judging criteria are explained in the *Rule Book*)

<b>Historical Quality (60%)</b>
• Entry is historically accurate
• Shows analysis and interpretation
• Places topic in historical context
• Shows wide research
• Uses available primary sources
• Research is balanced

<b>Relation to Theme (20%)</b>
• Clearly relates topic to theme
• Demonstrates significance of topic in history and draws conclusions

<b>Clarity of Presentation (20%)</b>
• Presentation, written material is original, clear, appropriate, organized and articulate
• Entry is organized, visual impact is appropriate to topic

<b>Rules Compliance</b>
• Maintains time requirement (10 minutes)
• Includes annotated bibliography
• All equipment student-run
• Other
